



Pilas Family Literacy Program - Cottage Grove

Position: Lead Childcare Teacher (in-person)

Downtown Languages, in partnership with Centro Latino Americano, South Lane School District, and Lane Community College, is seeking a Lead Childcare Teacher to care for and provide enrichment activities for young children and babies in the Pilas Family Literacy program in Cottage Grove.

The Pilas Family Literacy program is an 11-week evening program for families that provides ESL classes to adults, PreK and academic support for children in grades K-8, childcare, family learning activities, and celebrations of participating families' cultures. While established in other regional school districts, this is the first time the program is being offered in Cottage Grove. The program is typically operated twice during the academic year.

This program will serve families who speak Mam and Spanish as their primary language and require an individual with multicultural experience and sensitivity. It will be an in-person position with strict adherence to all COVID-19 protocols as detailed by the Oregon Department of Education.

Job Description

The Lead Childcare Teacher works with the Childcare Assistant and volunteers (when placed) to care for and teach children ages 0-3 years old.

Primary responsibilities are to:

- Prepare class materials and activities that will get toddlers ready to:
 - Enjoy and value reading
 - Recognize shapes and colors
 - Recognize numbers and count
 - Be interested in painting, drawing, modeling with clay, gluing, etc.
 - Sit in a circle during storytime
 - Follow instructions
 - Respect and share with others

- Guide infants in developmentally appropriate play and movement
- Create a classroom environment of respect
- Establish a culture for learning
- Manage student behavior equitably and fairly
- Guide and direct the Childcare Assistant Teacher
- Maintain hygienic care of all children

Secondary responsibilities are to:

- Guide volunteers (if any) in the childcare classroom
- Participate in select family activities
- Help maintain community partnerships by keeping shared teaching spaces clean and tidy
- Participate in all staff meetings
- Perform all other duties as requested

Requirements

- Proficient in two of these languages: Spanish, English, Mam
- Childcare experience, licensed childcare provider preferred
- Ability to pass a background check
- Must be able to lift 40 pounds
- Must have reliable transportation
